## INSPIRED ATTIRE

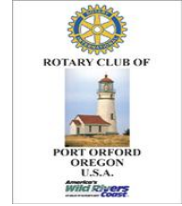
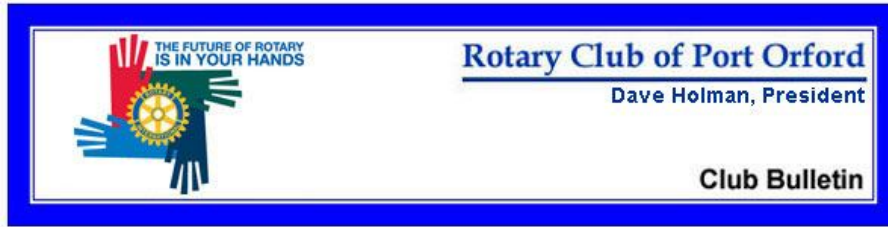
