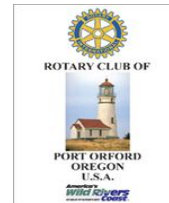
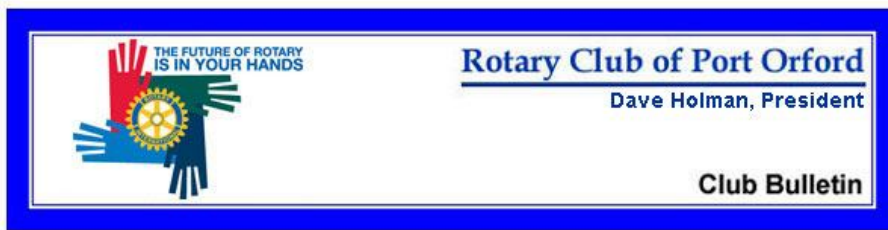


ROTARIANS DEDICATE BENCH TO REMEMBERED DEAD
