DISTRICT GOVERNOR VISITS

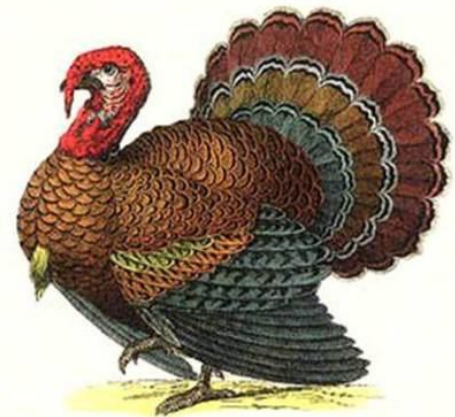
