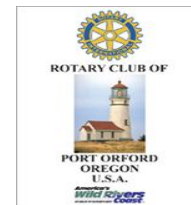
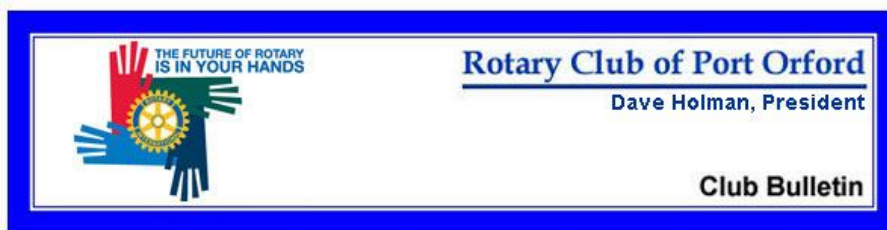
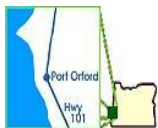


In addition to the wonderful Dinner Dance in April, another Scholarship benefit coming right up is the Golf Tournament at
